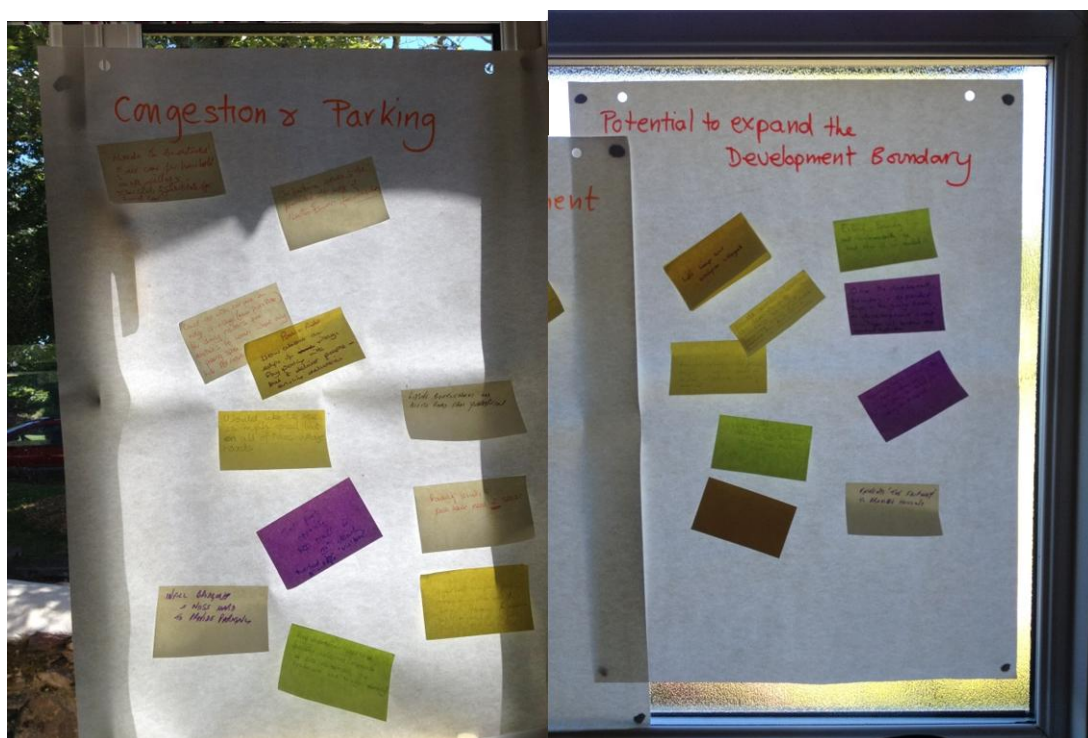


Comments from all consultation

Throughout the N3P process, face-to-face consultation has taken place in a wide variety of settings, locations and venues. In order to assimilate and organise all the feedback **ALL** verbatim comments were recorded. These comments were then used in Cluster Analysis

This included all the transcribed 'Post-it' comments, responses to structured events such as 'Bangers and Beer' and the early 'Vision' meetings of 2014/15. The written comments from the 'Shared Vision' were included also the school bus survey and the 'Roadshow' events.

All these comments were typed, and cut into individual comments. These were then sifted, sorted and 'clustered' by theme by the members of the Housing and Heritage working group.



Once sorted, each working group took away the comments that related to their own theme, retyped them and grouped and prioritised them and used them to contribute to the policies developed for inclusion in the Neighbourhood Plan. This also ensured that the policies developed were driven by resident and stakeholder views.

This information was supplemented by discussion papers, questionnaires and surveys both on-line and on paper to give greater depth and understanding which are covered elsewhere in the evidence and supporting documents.
